Ceramics

Projects are built and glazed in one class session. We bring all projects back to our site and fire them. Not all projects will be fired before the class is over, some projects will need to be delivered after.

Mud Pies & More

Students will create their own pots and sculptures. A variety of techniques will be explored including pinch, slab, and coil building.

Surreal Ceramics

Your students will have a blast making silly and surreal clay sculptures! Artists from the surrealist movement will inspire their unique clay projects.

Mud Monsters

Let your student's imagination run wild in this ceramics class where they create monsters, masks, and stories out of clay!

Sculpt-a-saurus

Learn about prehistoric beasts that walked the earth long ago! Different dinosaurs will inspire their clay sculptures each week.



Clay Safari

Explore and learn about animals in the wild kingdom! Students will make sculptures inspired by the animals they learn about each week.

Culture & Sculpture

Students will learn about sculpture and architecture of different cultures around the world. Students will then create a clay project inspired by what they learned!

Mapping the World in Clay

Investigate the clay artifacts of ancient cultures and make pots, sculptures, and figurines. A new culture is discussed each week.

Painting & Drawing

Create with Paint

Students will try their hand at painting still life, landscape, and animals. Watercolor, tempera paint and acrylic paint will be explored.

Draw Paws & Claws

Do your students love to draw critters and creatures? This class will break down drawing furry and crawly things into a simple step-by-step process. Lesson will depict hair, scales, composition and proportions.

Draw Prehistoric Paws & Claws

Take a trip back in time and learn about critters and creatures that walked the earth long ago. Students will use pastels, pencils, and more to explore the animals and environment of prehistoric times.

Beginning Drawing

Students will learn the fundamentals of drawing what they see including perspective and proportion.

Draw Folklore & More

Become a drawing wizard! Students will create their own drawings of creatures from folklore and more.

Drawing Safari

Embark on an artistic journey through drawing! Students will learn to draw elephants, giraffes, lions and more.

Paper & Mixed Media

Making Art with the Masters

Study the artwork of the masters and create pieces inspired by their techniques. Painting, drawing and printmaking will be explored and a new artist is discussed each week.

Scientific & Artistic Minds

Conduct scientific experiments that have artistic results. We will work with paint, clay, ink and more!

Pop-Up Art

Students will learn multiple paper folding methods to create their own pop-up cards and books. They will use drawing materials to bring their designs to life.
